Dear Mr Mike,

### **Circulation Discs (Road Licence Tax Discs)**

I refer to your letter, dated 12/4/2010, on the above subject and I would like to inform you that according to the provisions of the new legislation, that took effect from the 12<sup>th</sup> of March, 2010, the writing, attaching or displaying of any object on the windscreen of a vehicle is prohibited.

2. Nevertheless, the police do not charge, for the time being, people who display their circulation licences on their windscreen.
3. The reason is that an amendment of the legislation is expected to be done, in the near future, and regulation 23 of the motor vehicles regulations that provides for the displaying of circulation licences is going to be repealed.
4. Based on the above, even a fine cannot be issued to persons who display their circulation licence on the windscreen of their vehicle.
